 - If you already have a resume, please have a Career Specialist review it. If you need help creating a professional resume, schedule an appointment to complete one with a trained Career Specialist.
 - Remember to keep your resume up to date with keywords relevant to the job you want. We recommend uploading your professional resume on OhioMeansJobs.com for employers to begin viewing.
- Access to computers, internet, telephones, fax and copy machine, and resume paper
- Guidance on OhioMeansJobs.com Ohio's best website to search and apply for jobs
 - OhioMeansJobs.com is internet based so it's available to you 24/7. In addition to your job search, you can discover career pathways, career assessment, practice interviewing and online training. We recommend starting with the guided tour and completing your profile.
